What does the work of LouNC look like?

- Meetings are held monthly, in-person and hosted by LouNC members.
- Meetings include strategy setting around local, state, and federal policy engagement; education and discussion of key issues impacting members, the nonprofit sector, and the Louisville Metro community; information on funding opportunities and strategies; visits with invited guests informing the Coalition's work; advocacy training; and an opportunity to learn from, network with, and collaborate with other members.
- Engagement with policy makers, including federal delegates, state legislators representing Louisville, and Louisville Metro Councilmembers and the Mayor's administration.
- A strong, unified nonprofit voice with public officials and in public meetings.
