Total Annual Revenue: \$477.3 million

48% Program Revenue (\$226.7 million)
(including fee for service income and government grants and contracts)

46% Contributed Revenue (\$220.4 million)
(private donations from individuals, foundations, corporations, and bequests)

6% Other Revenue (\$30.6 million)
(investment and interest income, etc.)
